Now, after an accomplished career in journalism, Jeff has embarked on a new professional journey. From the time when he became a pilot as a teenager, Jeff has loved aviation and aerospace. Now he is combining his communication skills with that love as a Communications Specialist with Virgin Galactic, the pioneering space company dedicated to opening space to as many people as possible.

Over his journalism career, Jeff has covered every major Southern California news event in the past thirty years including the arrest of Rodney King, the LA Riots, the arrest and trial of O.J. # **Dennis Anderson Antelope Valley Regional Panel Moderator**

Dennis L. Anderson is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker at High Desert Medical Group in Lancaster, with emphasis on working with veterans and military families. He serves as Supervisor Kathryn Barger's appointee on the Los Angeles County Veterans Advisory Commission. Army service included Airborne parachutist qualification in U.S. Army Europe.

His military experience extended to covering the Iraq War as an embedded journalist. As chief Editor of the Antelope Valley Press, Mr. Anderson deployed with the first California National Guard unit sent to the Iraq War.



Mr. Anderson entered the mental health field after witnessing the psychological toll on troops he reported about. As Post 9/11 wars extended, he observed rising rates of military and veteran suicide and Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder.

As a clinical social worker, he assists veterans with mental health issues, obtaining earned VA benefits, housing and education. To honor the legacy of World War II Airborne troops at Normandy, France, in June 2022 Mr. Anderson made two military parachute jumps for the 78th Anniversary of D-Day. Mr. Anderson's father was a WWII veteran, Army Europe.

With his efforts to embrace hydrogen, he has earned the City of Lancaster the title of the "First Hydrogen City." His vision for hydrogen as a way to further decarbonize the city has led to Lancaster attracting innovative hydrogen projects from around the world including the launch of a Sister Cities Program focused on furthering hydrogen development with Namie, Japan.

Parris is also an accomplished lawyer and the chairman for CarthroniX, a biotech firm working to develop several drugs that treat degenerative diseases.

# Art Thompson Executive Board Chairman CEO Sage Cheshire, Inc.

Red Bull Stratos Technical Project Director Art Thompson has over 44 years of experience in aerospace conceptual design and fabrication, managing engineers and fabricators to produce major milestones in aerospace history including projects such as the B2 Stealth Bomber. Art as technical project director for Red Bull Stratos conceptualized the process for assembling the mission's extraordinary team and drove all aspects of technical development of the project such as the capsule design and fabrication, flight test and life support systems, space suit modification,



safety systems, altitude chamber tests, mission profiles and flight operations. Red Bull Stratos was a flight-test program designed to develop high altitude egress and safety systems in the event of a flat spin, DCS, embolism or conditions from a rapid decompression in a near space environment. The program set a record for free fall from 128K feet at MACH 1.25 (843.6 mph). The technical outcome provided benefits in life support, egress and survival from high altitude and near space environments.

Art co-founded Sage Cheshire Aerospace, Inc., and is also president of A2ZFX Inc., providing concept, design, fabrication and solutions to just about any project for clients from housing, energy, water, automotive concept design, aerospace manufacturing and product development, prototype medical devices, movie vehicles and props. His company, Sage Cheshire Aerospace, and A2ZFX are located in Lancaster, CA.

Art is a member of the Aerospace Medical Association (AsMA), American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA), National Aeronautical Association (NAA), Society of Experimental Test Pilots (SETP, corporate member), and the Chairman of the Board of the Air Force Flight Test Historical Foundation and Flight Test Museum Foundation at Edwards AFB. He is International Association for the Advancement of Space Safety (IAASS) Space Safety 2013 Jerome Lederer Pioneer Award recipient; 2012 Collier Trophy nominee; 2012 Laurette Award nominee; 2013 Excellence in Aviation Award recipient from the Flight Test Historical Foundation; Hall of Fame 2013 Inductee, San Diego Air and Space Museum; Honorary U.S. Army Golden Knight; recognized by the New Mexico and California Senates for contributions in aerospace and human physiology egress from high altitude; Royal Aeronautical Society 2018 Specialist award recipient for advancements in the aerospace industry.

Steve's latest book is Reviving America: How Repealing Obamacare, Replacing the Tax Code and Reforming The Fed will Restore Hope and Prosperity co-authored by Elizabeth Ames (McGraw-Hill Professional).

Steve writes editorials for each issue of Forbes under the heading of "Fact and Comment." A widely respected economic prognosticator, he is the only writer to have won the highly prestigious Crystal Owl Award four times. The prize was formerly given by U.S. Steel Corporation to the financial journalist whose economic forecasts for the coming year proved most accurate.

In both 1996 and 2000, Steve campaigned vigorously for the Republican nomination for the Presidency. Key to his platform were a flat tax, medical savings accounts, a new Social Security system for working Americans, parental choice of schools for their children, term limits and a strong national defense. Steve continues to energetically promote this agenda.
